<p>Organism</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • made of organ systems • entire living being • living 	<p>Molecule</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 or more bonded atoms • nonliving 
<p>Macromolecule</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • large molecules • biomolecules • nonliving 	<p>Tissue</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • group of same type of cell • cells work together • living 
<p>Cell</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • made up of organelles • basic unit of structure and function • living 	<p>Organ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • group of tissues working together • living 
<p>Organelle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • made up of macromolecules • tiny organ • nonliving 	<p>Organ System</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • organs that work together • system performs a function • living 
<p>Atom</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • smallest neutral part of matter • nonliving 	<p>Levels of Organization</p>
